Children are to wear **SPORTS UNIFORM** and **MUST** have a **HAT** to participate.

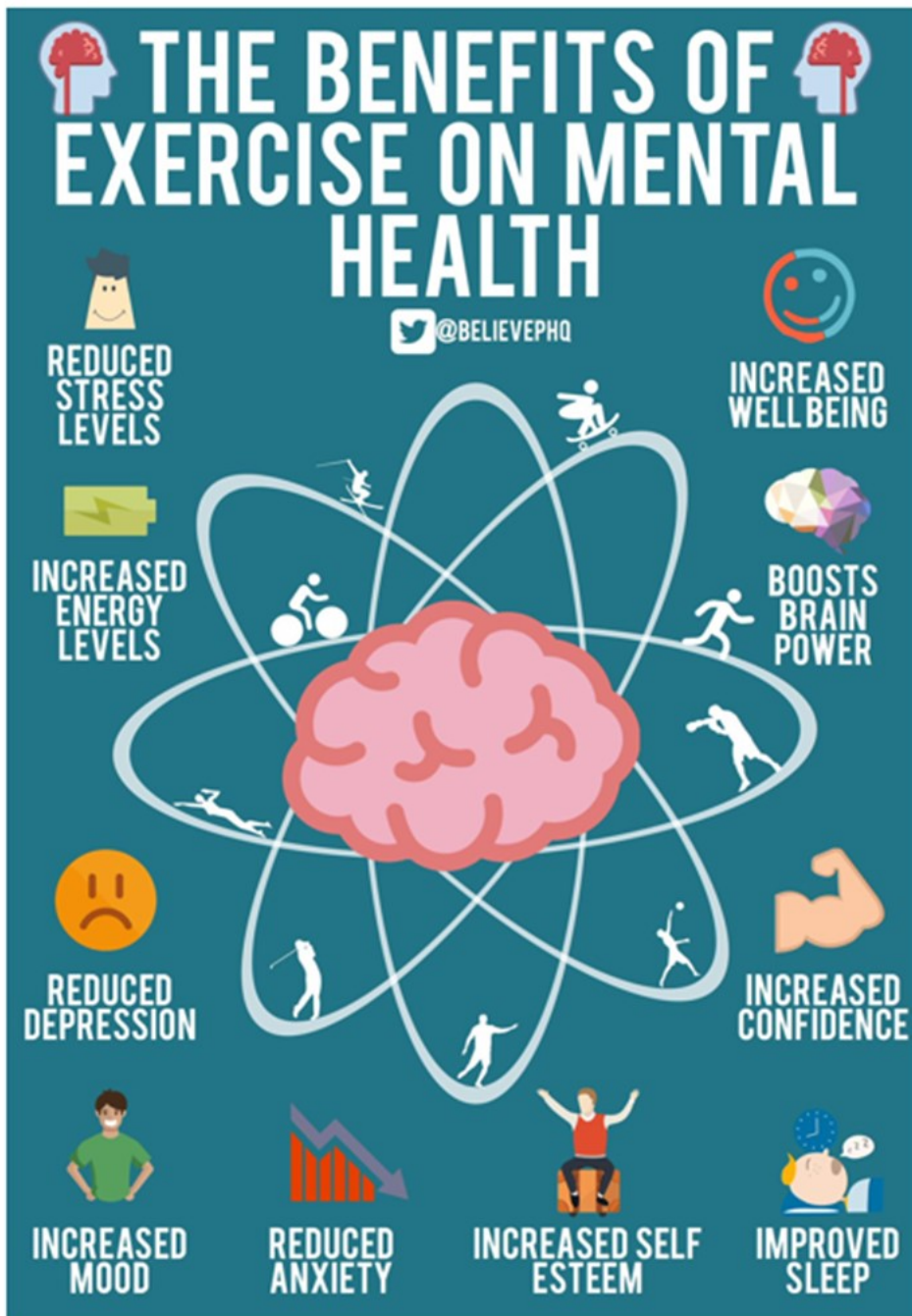
