**Touch Football Gala Day** (Years 3-6) - Wednesday 5th.

Students in who are participating, will be departing for Gunnedah at 9.30am by Keam's Bus service. Students are reminded to wear their sports uniform and sneakers, and bring their school hat, sunscreen, recess, lunch and water. The bus is expected to return to school by 2.30pm. Students not attending this event are expected to attend school as normal.

**Speakfest** - Thursday 6th.

All students will be participating. Please have students at the Gunnedah Public School by

9am for a 9:30am start. Parents will need to **sign in** at the front office upon arrival. Students are required to wear their full school uniform.

**MILO T20 Blast Cricket Day** (Years 3-6) - Friday 7th.

The school will now be providing **Keam's bus** to transport students in Years 3-6 to Gunnedah for this event. The bus will be departing the school immediately upon dropping students off from the normal bus run in the morning. Parents are required to have their students at school by 8.40am. The bus will be returning by 3pm.

Students to wear school sports uniform, sneakers and take their school hat, sunscreen, recess, lunch and water. An amended permission note is attached. Please return to school by **Tuesday 4th September**.

### Lake Keepit Excursion

Our whole school excursion to Lake Keepit will take place during Week 10, 24th - 28th September. Students in years K, 1 and 2 will only be attending for 2 days. Normal classes will be held for the rest of the week. The school will meet the cost of programs, instruction and accommodation for all
