of 6 and 18 to attend school. Once enrolled in a school, children are required to attend school each day it is open for students. We understand that occasionally students are absent from school and these are classed as justified or unjustified. It is up to the discretion of the principal to accept an explanation that has been provided, or if they believe that it is not in the best interest of the child it can be marked as unjustified. Following an absence from school, parents must provide a written or verbal explanation for the absence within 7 days. However, if the school has not received an explanation from parents within 2 days, the school will make contact to discuss the absence.

If, for any reason, families are experiencing financial, emotional, social or medical hardship and are keeping students' home from school as a result, please feel free to make an appointment through the school to speak to Mr Carter to discuss assistance opportunities.
