Canberra Excursion

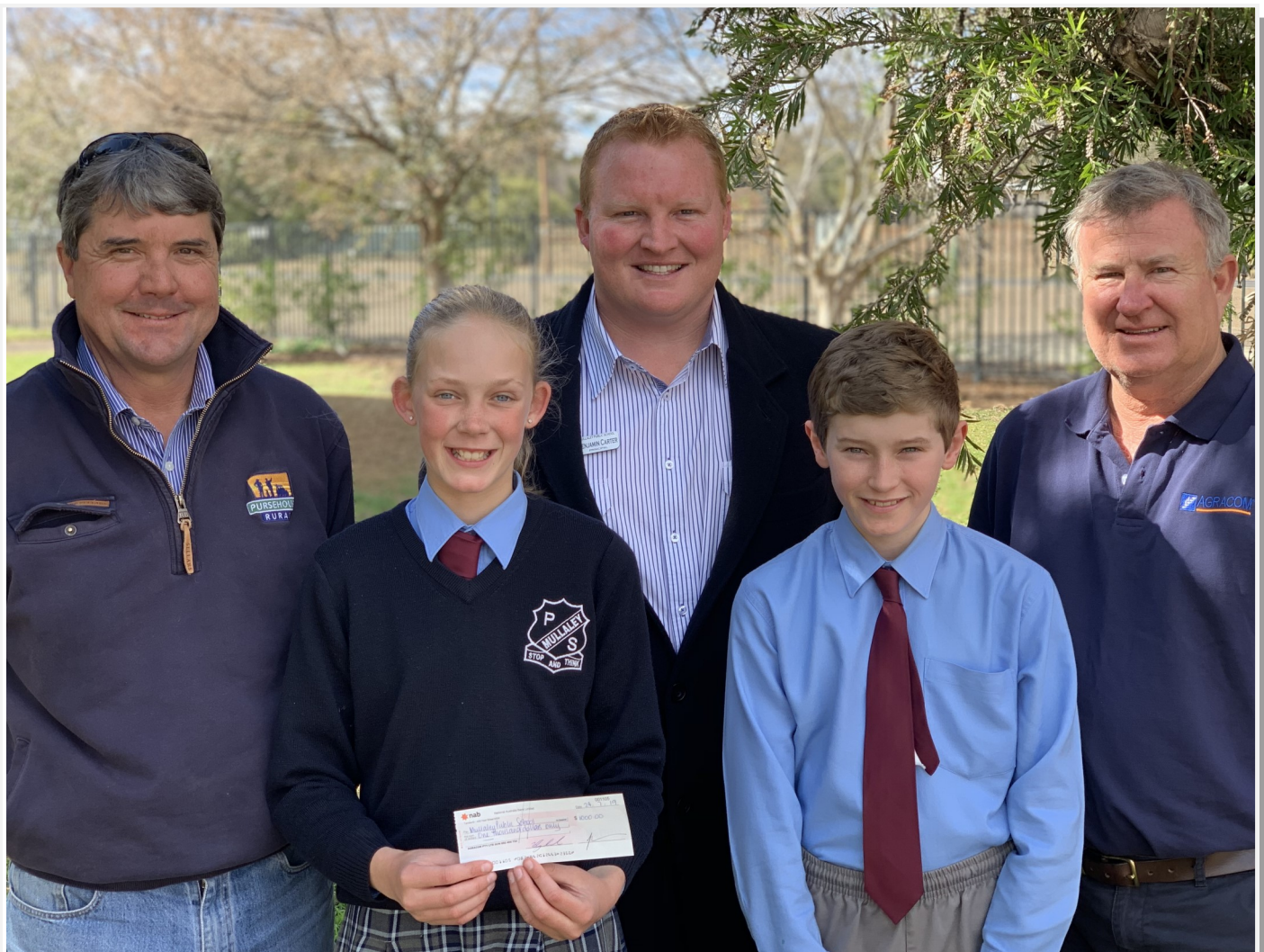
